Our Independent National Whistleblowing Officer team have launched their programme of events for Speak Up Week running from 30 September – 4 October 2024.

It will feature events and activities supporting healthcare workers in Scotland to speak up and improve patient safety.

Throughout the week, senior NHS leaders will take part in live, interactive discussions exploring how to enable and support all healthcare workers to speak up confidently and safely when they spot a patient safety issue.
